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Current situation of participation in student clubs of the sport management students in Bac Ninh sport University- Vietnam

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Abstract

The student club is one of the places where activities bring a lot of positive results for students. This is both a training and learning environment and a place for exchanging and connecting students together and at the same time acting as an extracurricular activity. During the research process, we used usual research methods to assess the current situation of activities of students in sports management industry at the student clubs of Bac Ninh University of Sports. This is an important basis for us to conduct research to build a student club model of sports management industry.

Introduction

Over 60 years of construction and growth, BacNinh University of Sports - Vietnam has achieved important achievements, contributing significantly to the development of the sports industry as well as the industrialization and modernization of country. The InterCommunist Youth Union of the Faculty of management is an organization affiliated to the HCM Communist Youth Union - BacNinh Sport University. As Sports Management Sector, this inter communist has just been established, with experience and performance not much compared to other communist. The organization system of union activities is lacking in science, the annual Union operation plan is sufficient in number but inefficient in terms of quality and especially the lack of organized activities (clubs) exclusively for students major in sports management. The characteristics of students in sports management are limited in practical learning as well as the ability to improve Vietnamese for foreign students in Laos and Cambodia. Therefore, the assessment of the actual status of student clubs in sports management students will be an important basis for studying and building a model of sports club students for sport management.

Research Methods

To solve the research objectives, the thesis has used the following 6 usual research methods:

Methods of analyzing and synthesizing documents

This is a widely used method in theoretical and pedagogical scientific works. The research process referred to 15 physical-related documents such as instructions and resolutions of the Party and the State on the youth work, the Resolution of the General Assembly, Viet Nam - BacNinh Sport University for the term of 2017 - 2019, Resolution of the General Conference of the inter-communist youth union for the term 2016 – 2019. By this method, the topic has collected 2 documents of the Party and the State on youth, 4 research documents to the organization union activities, 9 documents directly related to the theory of sports and the characteristics of union organization with students.

Pedagogical observation method

We use the pedagogical observation method in the research process to assess the participation of students in student clubs of sports management, thereby identifying the causes of limitations in the process of study and practice

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Methods of interview and seminar

We interviewed 20 students of the Sports Management Department about the necessity of joining student clubs, and assessed the status of student clubs' participation, thereby finding limitations. in union activities.

Methods of Mathematical Statistics

In the process of processing topic data, the parameter and the public mathematical Statistics fomular is presented in the book "Sports Measurement" and the project proceeded with processing and checking data on the Excel software system The typical parameters we use include:

a. Arithmetic average (\bar{X}) is calculated by the formula:

Results and Discussion

The current status of activities in the student clubs by sport management students, BacNinh Sport Uniniversity, Viet Nam

The current statusof needs and participation level in students club by Sport Management students

The Sports Club for Students of Sports Management is a place for young people to express themselves, to show their ability of enthusiasm, bravery, creativity as well as the ability to organize and lead. Through these activities, the members also improve the practical knowledge in life that is not available in books.

To assess the situation of the needs and the level of participation in the student club of sports management students, we conducted interviews with 20 members - students of Sports Management. The results are presented in Table 1.

The table 1 shows that: The demand for participation in the student club of students of Sports Management is very high (with the percentage of 95% at the very necessary level, especially 100% of students think that joining the student club is necessary). This is an important basis for us to build a student club model of sports management to meet the needs.

The reality of a number of factors that ensure the operation of student club by sport management students,

BacNinh Sport University

The reality of sport management staff and lecturers.

Sports management department is a unit of school administrators, is responsible for academic in training, science and technology activities.

The situation of the staff and lecturers participating in the management and teaching of students of sport management at BacNinh Sports University is shown in Table 2.

From the results obtained in Table 2 shows:

About professional qualifications: 100% of staff and lecturers of sports management have completed the postgraduate training program, of which there are 6/10 PhD students, accounting for 60.00%, 4/10 Master degrees, accounting for 40.00%, 3 lecturers have associate professor level (30%).

Regarding the age and working experience involved in teaching, 100% of staff and lecturers under the age of 50 years old, at the same time having 6 years of working experience for 6/9 people, accounting for 66,67%

The young and qualified teaching staff will be an important basis in orienting the replication of the Student Club model of

sports management

Situation of facilities serving the training of bachelor in sport management

Facilities, lecturers, facilities, teaching and learning materials are the factors that greatly affect the quality of training. In recent years, BacNinh Sports University has paid special attention to facilities to ensure the training goals of the school. The reality of materials for theoretical teaching for students of Sports Management Department at BacNinh Sports University is presented in version 3

Search Results Table 3 show:

Number of books published after 2007 (the beginning of the opening of the sport management bachelor's degree program) significantly increase compared to before 2007 (reaching 18, 18%). This is a favorable condition for organizing group study sessions and scientific activities for student according to student club model.

The situation of staffs and facilities for sport management students participating in union work at BacNinh Sports University.

In order to assess the status of facilities, tools and equipment for the activities of the Confederation, we conduct statistics of the system of facilities for the unions' activities. a member of Sports Management Department. Specific results are presented in Table 4.

The results obtained from Table 4 show:

Regarding the human factor: 100% of union staffs managed by the Union are union officers, but no specialized union officials.

Venue, activities, union and equipment for service: lack of quantity and poor quality.

Equipment and assistive technology: there has been an investment in facilities for student activities (guitar and

Oocgan for the school's music team; creating conditions for the music team to practice 2 sessions / week at Union office).

The situation, participation level in student clubs of sport management students, BacNinh Sport university.

To assess objectively the current status of student clubs of sport management students, we conducted interview 20 sport management students in 3 levels: Frequently, seldom and not participate. The result is presented in table 5.

Table 5 show that, most students majoring in sport management are not participating in student club of university (counting for 75-95%), especially there are no students participated in “light up the country road” club.

This is the main reason for the limitation of management students activities (especially for Lao and Campodia foreign

students)

In order to have a more comprehensive assessment of the factors affecting the operation of clubs of students of sports management, we conducted interviews with 20 students about the above factors. Results are presented in Table 6

From the results of Table 6 shows that most students think that the time to join the club is difficult, the way of organizing the club's activities is not attractive, the cost for training is expensive. This is The reasons leading to the limitations in the activities of the student clubs of BacNinh Sports University

Conclude

By assessing the status of activities at student club of sport management student show: the need to join student club of sport management student is huge; sport management staffs and lecturers has met the needs set out. But there are still some limitations such as: lack of facilities and equipment for club activities in terms of quantity and quality...

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
